We the entire members of ogbodo igbeagu community wish to use this medium to express our unended profound gratitude to Samuel Omogo Foundation in honoring Rev. Fr.Dr. Peter Omogo for our unmerited favor that God grant to us through him by drilling a portable and heavenly taste borehole in our village.

The Foundation has become another savior to all humanities across the globe. There is no doubt that they said "water is life" the Foundation has saved a lot of souls by giving many people water for free in desistation of sentimentalism in his philanthropist work both the believer and unbeliever, Christians and Muslims and people of diverse ethnicities around the world.

However, Omogo Foundation, has distinguished animals from humanity by providing a healthy water to the people, here in our community, we use to drink in the same pond or stream with an animal both domestic and wild which has caused a lot of harmful disease to us. Many people have died as the result of the disease gotten from the unhealthy water they consume.

Furthermore, Omogo foundation has released a lot of suffering from the members of our community especially during dry season, the era of water scarcity. On before now our people trek from our village to another community in search of water for the survival of our livelihood both the old and young. This journey sometimes took us 4-6 kilometers before our arrival and the suffering didn't end there, we will still wait for up to 21-23 hours before our turn to fetch water.

Sometimes some members of other community where we went for water, insult our members and give us all sort of words but we still endure all these insult because there is no other hope for water.

Today, our second Jesus Christ has visited us and save our lives and totally eradicated all these suffering, insults, stresses, searching of water in another village, trekking from 4-6 kilometers, time wasting for our turn to fetch water, drinking from the same pond or stream with animals and premature death as the result of unhealthy water consumption, through Rev. Fr. Dr Peter Omogo.


Father, we therefore solicited for more help in water assistance in our village because out of the seven zones in our community only two has borehole while others are still dragging water in the same pond or stream with animal.

In the history of people of Ndiagu Arigbo Village in Inyimagu, Okposhi Ehekun Community, today will ever remains memorable and unforgettable. Thank God who has made this day a reality through our dear beloved Rev. Father Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo, glory be to God. (Ndu Ngboejeogu eiya, unu Nwutaru eshi nwa).

The sufferings of this particular village over years, in search of drinking water cannot be over emphasized. Father, you may know that apart from the fact that our health situation is erroneously threatened by so many diseases associated with bad water system. Our people also suffered a lot of inhuman, cruel, barbaric and sadistic threats from neighboring communities and villages, just in search of good drinking water. Just to mention but a few; unknown people will always hide in the bush to snatch pot and bucket of our people, most of our girls was raped, and most of children got lost. As a result of the above incidents we recorded high number of death rate and teenage pregnancy.

We first experienced a relieve from the above ugly scenario mentioned above in the year 2018 when the first Borehole by Samuel Omogo Foundation was drilled at a nearby village Otuokpeye Inyimagu. We celebrated that Saviour has come, but little did we know that our problem was not yet over as at then. This is because the then only borehole available serving about four different villages around was over crowded.

Though, the people managing the borehole was offering a fare service to all sundry, but the crowd was so intimidating to the point that some people will not be able to fetch the water for up to two or three times in a week of 7 days (you could imagine). The unfair situation almost pushed us back to the former water state. But thank God for Rev. Father Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo, a revered priest of the Living God.

Father,, I wish to say that the importance and benefits of this borehole cannot be recorded in one note book. Before now, our people use to travel for about 10 to 15km inside the bush in search of water. The journey is not only far, but full of risky of life and exposes life into danger, more especially now that Fulani herdsmen is everywhere threatening lives and property. With the donation of this borehole, at least our lives are safe and more secured. Bear it in mind that history cannot forget that the overwhelming victory over sufferings and threats was achieved by God through the responsiveness of dearly Rev. Father Dr. Peter Okwueze Omogo.

Considering the quality of your sequence responsiveness and distinct exhibition of plight over people's welfare, we own this enquiry to make, (and what is it?) we considered it necessarily to enquire if Rev. Father's and Revered priest of God accept chieftaincy and traditional title then, I believe my people will co-operate with me, with one voice and mind to consider you for an outstanding chieftaincy Title *"Ezigbo Nwa Chineke I of Ebonyi and "Mmiri Na-ezoro ora I of Igbo Land"*.

We cannot forget in our dally prayers to pray for the family of Don and Jean who are supporting the Samuel Omogo Foundation in this humanitarian service. Even the memories of their forefathers shall continue to be blessed.



We know that whenever you set out your hand for anything, you never bring it down until your heart desire is accomplished.



The village however is bounded in the east by promise land and Ameffia in the west by Ndiagu Obu Ameffia in the north by Inyagu Otuokpeye Ameffia and in the south by Ojiegbe Ngbo and Ogbana Ntezi Ishielu LGA. Ndiagu Okpurukpu has estimated population of about three thousand (3000) people including women and children. Most of the villagers engaged in both subsistence and commercial agriculture but since the existence of this village, one of the major problems obstructing their activities is water scarcity and non availability of clean water for domestic and other needs but today, history has changed from village of no water to a village of sufficient water funded by this philanthropic organization Samuel Omogo's Foundation.
- **NOTE:** Ndiagu Okpurukpu people have been suffering from decreasing in population due to contamination of several water born diseases and bacterial infections like guinea worm, cholera, diarrhea, tuberculosis and many others that can't be pen down here but has drastically reduced since the intervention of Samuel Omogo's Foundation in our neighboring village like Ndiagu Eze and promise land who benefited years back from this foundation.
