It was unbelievable when the journey started last year January, 2018. To many it was like building castle in the air" but today it is a fulfilled reality to God's glory.

In the history of this village, water and electricity had been to us, "a never to think- about" issues but today your foundation has broken the stronghold of water poverty, yet to handle that of electricity by his grace. Water, they say is life, and indeed you have brought us life.

In December, 2017 a story was heard by one of the villagers heralding the good of Samuel Omogo foundation's philanthropic works. The villagers came and he announced to the entire village what heard as has been our culture here. Sequel to the announcement was a letter presented to you on the 12th January, 2018. Why we sent this letter in much a do" was the fact that we needed this water the way Egyptians needs the nile. water always for them to wash their cloths and bath. So also our wives and their environment. Our domestic chores are done better with water than what it is used to be. We expunge the fear of wild animal attacking our children on our various roads while in search for water. Like I have said before, we cannot list out our benefits from this borehole in a day even weeks. But in all, believes it that we are the happiest village in the whole world because of God had used Samuel Omogo foundation to do for us. We because of the importance of the facility that constitute nine men committee who will undertake the responsibility of the facility management and maintenance to ensure sustainability.

The village is very vast such that some track about five kilometers before they can benefit from this borehole, we therefore pray the Samuei Omogo foundation to please assist us the more in the drilling more boreholes. We are not asking out of greed but like Oliver Twist, we need some more and with your good heart, we know you will not frown at this We are even depending on you for our power source. Electricity by God's grace. The book of Mathew chapter 7 vs 7 - 8 has it that we shall ask in good manners. The same scriptures in the book of Philippians 4 vs 13 assure you that with Christ Jesus what straightens you, you can do all things. So we believe you can do all things for the good people of Ndiagu Ishiagu village, Amaeffia Ngbo.

AN ADDRESS OF WELCOME PRESENTED BY ELDER AMOS ALI OGE ON THE OCCASION OF THE COMMISSIONING OF A BOREHOLE BY REV. FR. PETER O. OMOGO THIS DAY SATURDAY 12TH JANUARY, 2019.

PROTOCOL PREAMBLE:

I am glad to witness today's memorable event in the history of Ndiagu Ishinyi Village. It is a serious surprise and clear indication of divine intervention towards changing our story for good. The people of this village have seriously witnesses part of hell fire especially during dry seasons. But today, our women and children are breaking the silence sequel to the availability of clean water in home inside home.

WHY WE REQUESTED FOR THE BOREHOLE

Ndiagu Ishinyi was believed to be the oldest hamlet in Okposhi Nkwolu apart from Ndiulo Okposhi according to history. The village has existed over hundred years ago. It is in this village that most of the valuable treasures and monumental statues of Okposhi Nkwolu are located, amongst which are the oldest secondary school in Ngboejeogu- CSS Okposhi Eheku, the sacred forest — Alisako and the Ishinyi river to mention but a few.

The pains of water scarcity experienced by the people here is quite innumerable. Suffice to say that most of the sudden deaths recorded in this land is attributed to dirty water. People travel a long distance to fetch dirty water to be treated before drinking it. Some persons who do not have enough treatment mechanism may drink it raw and hence contact serious water borne diseases such as Guinea worm, Dysentery, cholera and chronic diseases.

That notwithstanding, there were various other challenges encountered following the scarcity of water. Some of those traumas may include: tiredness, dirtiness, deity and masquerade rituals attack, attack from dangerous animals — venoms of snakes and mad dogs, scorpion etc. This situation, perhaps were the roots of family crises such as divorce since immorality were given opportunity, when a married woman spend two or more nights in search of water. Efforts have been intensified to provide alternative but these never yielded a maximum result.

BENEFITS OF THE BOREHOLE

It stands to reason, therefore, that the existence of this borehole is a right step in a right direction, where

i. We can fetch water with ease

- ii. It will reduce gossip, quarrel and fight among our women.
- iii. It will remove water poisoning
- iv. Such pathogens of water borne disease are things of the past.
- v. Women will have no reason to prepare food very late in the night.
- vi. Men will have no reason too in suspecting their wives of keeping late outside.
- vii. Our children can now drink clean water
- viii. And it will bring about longevity.

HOW TO JEALOUSLY GUIDE THE BOREHOLE

It is our utmost concern to secure the borehole so that it will last long. Before now, strategies have been on ground to carry out this function effectively both physical and spiritual means especially through our leaders. We shall devise other possible means to secure the borehole so that the effort of **Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF)** by **Rev. Fr. Peter O. Omogo** will not be a waste. Some of these strategies shall be published as follows:

- i. Routinely fetching of water of first come, first served
- ii. We shall appoint some groups from the village to keep vigilance and reports same to the leaders who will sanction any offender.
- iii. We shall wash and clean the borehole environment at regular interval.
- iv. Above all we shall establish a market square close to the borehole area to enable us watch over it.

We pray that God will continue to strengthen you, bless you with sound health of mind and body, guide and protect you and above all, help you to continue doing His will. In Jesus name we pray! Amen!

The spiritual Director and Founder, Samuel Omogo Foundation, Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo, and his entourage, elders of Onunwafia Ndiogodo village, Distinguished guests, ladies and gentlemen, it is our pleasure to welcome you all to this auspicious occasion of the commissioning of a borehole provided by Samuel Omogo Foundation to the yearning people of this village.

It may interest you to know that before now the people of this village had been disadvantageously placed in geographical location where scarcity of water is the major problem of the inhabitants. This is because there are no rivers or streams near the village nor can one find any social amenities like pipe borne water which is supposed to be provided by the government. It is based on these problems that our women and children have to travel about seven (7) kilometres to fetch water from Okpiho and Owiriwo streams at Otuebu and Aguebele villages.

To ameliorate this harsh conditions which get worsened during the dry season, individuals who are privileged to afford the cost decided to dig water wells in their homes while so many families which cannot afford the cost of digging a well are left at the mercy their neighborhood. Even the wells so dug by few families do not stand the test of time as most of them dry up before December every year and so the villagers depend on dirty ponds as the only source of water.

Suffice it to say that we have been subjected to various problems occasioned by this scarcity of drinkable water thus:

- 1. Our people especially women and children contact avoidable diseases such as cholera, typhoid fever, diarrheoa, dysentry, worms, couphs etc.
- 2. Our children absent themselves from school or go late to school as a result of long trek in search of water.
- 3. Our economic programmes especially agricultural activities are paralyzed as most of our man-hour is spent in the morning in search of water.
- 4. Our children who go from one place to another in search of water are prone to harassment from unsuspecting criminals who seize the opportunity to intimidate, beat or even rape our children.

Consequent upon the above predicament therefore, we appended to Samuel Omogo Foundation in December, 2017, seeking for her intervention in providing a borehole for the village.

When on 8th December 2018 a team of engineers/surveyors who introduced themselves as having been sent by Samuel Omogo Foundation visited our village and surveyed the environment to identify where water could be found, we thought it was a joke. However on 14th December, 2018 the drilling team came and did their good work and within a short time of arrival they said "let there be water" and there was water. To God be the glory. The borehole was finally fixed on 20th December, 2018 amidst jubilation by the villagers.

As this borehole is being commissioned today, the 14th January, 2019, we express our immense gratitude to Almighty God who made it possible for us to be remembered by Samuel Omogo Foundation. We appreciate you Rev. Father Peter Okwoeze Omogo, a philanthropist of first order for having brought succour to so many indigent citizens of not only Ngbo clan but entire Ebonyi State. We pray God to continue to provide for you as you are providing for the needy. Water is life and whoever provides water provides life and so we wish you long life and prosperity.

We assure you that we shall guard and ensure the safety of the borehole so that the aim of providing the borehole will not be jeopardized.

We pray God to grant all our visitors journey mercies back to their various destinations.

2. Gratitude

This is a special day made by the Lord and indeed we are glad. Indeed I am glad to welcome on behalf of the entire Ndiagu Atukpa Village, Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo and other members of Samuel Omogo Foundation here present. *Unu tokwa ehu*.

Today history is made in this village as our age-long dream of having a permanent source of clean water has been fulfilled. This achievement is no thanks to the government which has abnegated its social and constitutional responsibility to use tax-payers' money, our money, to provide for the people, basic social amenities.

Rather, we own it to you, Samuel Omogo Foundation, a non-governmental organization that out of generosity and God-driven compassion to better the living standard of rural dwellers like us, decided to finance this project from the very beginning to this point where we are now commissioning it for use. We thank you our benefactor and all your development partners who contributed generously towards the success of this project. You have wiped away our tears. *Unu dike*.

3. Why We Need This Project

The need for this project cannot be overemphasized. Perennial water scarcity is the bane of this community. We depend on personal sunk shallow wells, rain water during raining season, streams and ponds as sources of water for domestic use, drinking and other uses. These unhygienic water sources expose our people to heath hazards such as cholera, guinea worm and other water-borne diseases.

During harmattan or dry season as now, we are completely thrown into difficulty as all our women and children even sometime our men go in search of water. We travel sometimes as far as Ekwashi community in search of water which is not even hygienic. This predisposes our women and children to attacks by members of these other

communities and their masquerades in an effort to guard their water sources jealously. Our children in times like this always attend school late because they wake up daily in search of water first before thinking of school. Again as farmers we lose man-hours daily as the search for water takes most of the time of our women during water scarcity.

4. Benefits of this Borehole

With the above scenario painted about our condition before now, no one, not even the blind can claim ignorance of the benefits of this project. This borehole will go a long way in ameliorating our suffering and difficulty associated with water scarcity. The travel to distance places will now be a thing of the past, just as our children will go to school on time and appear neat as others. Our farm activities will equally get the needed attention as the situation of using the entire day or half of it to search for water is brought to an end.

Above all now we have a sure source of clean water which will reduce drastically the incidence of water borne-diseases among the villagers. It is a time to bid-good bye to cholera, guinea worm etc. Generally, the cleanliness and the state of hygiene of our community will be enhanced.

5. Protection and Maintenance of the Project

I wish to assure you that we will jealously guard and protect this project so that your kind gesture will not be in vain and more so, our people are not thrown back into the wilderness in search of water again.

In view of this, we have put measures in place to ensure that:

- 1. children below 10 years do not operate the bore hole.
- 2. people will always queue up and take their turns on the basis of first-come, first-served to operate the borehole and avoid unnecessary injuries.
- 3. the operating hours will be from 6am in the morning to 7pm in the evening. This is to ensure that the borehole is operated only during the day time and not at odd-hours.
- 4. in case of any damage, the village will see to the repair.

To achieve all the above and to ensure that this God-given project is sustained, my leadership has set-up borehole committee led by Mr. Esheya Vincent. I am confident that with this committee we shall not abuse the privilege your foundation has extended to us by siting this borehole in our midst.

5. Appeal

On behalf of the village let me solicite that you grant us the favour of sinking at least one more borehole in this village. It is clear that only one cannot serve a community as populous as ours. We believe that if this is achieved, it will go a long way in eradicating the problem of water scarcity and its attendant hardship amongst our people.

6. Appreciation

Once more on behalf of this village, I thank Samuel Omogo Foundation led by an illustrious son of Ngbo Ejeogu, Rev Fr. Peter Omogo. You have by your philanthropic gestures written your name in gold in Ngbo Ejiogu and beyond. We wish you and your development partners, God's blessings and favours so that you will continue to touch positively the lives of the down -trodden. We remember our dear brother Samuel Omogo in whose name this foundation was established. We pray that God's perpetual light will continue to shine on him and all the faithful departed.

Final accept this token as a sign of our love and deepest appreciation of what you have done for us. We can't reward you but we pray that God who knows how best to reward you should reward you immensely.

OKPOCHIRM AMOKALO IN UKPOJHI WHO A WELCOME ADDRESS PRESENTED THIS DAY 14TH JANUARY 2019 TO REV. FR. PETER OMOGO ON THE OCCASION OF COMMISSION CEREMONY OF A BOREHOLE BUILT BY HIM (REV. FR. PETER OMOGO) AND DONATED TO OPKOCHIRU AMOKWO IN OKPOSHIESHI AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITY NGBO OF OHAUKWU LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA.

Good Day Ladies and Gentlemen

While we're excited to have you all this day, we'd especially like to say welcome to Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo who is the reason why we are here today.

We are also delighted to welcome the Regent of Okposhi Eshi Autonomous community prince Oda Godwin Omogo who has found time out of his tight scheduled to be with us.

We say welcome to all and sundry and we ask everyone of you to feel at home.

Our 40 years ago, Amokwo conceived the idea of protecting her territorial boundaries against any foreseen and unforeseen external intrusion. The most considered porous was this axis bound by Izhia Community. A decision was taken to create a residential area here. That is when this village called Okpochiru was born.

Young, able bodied and fearless men were allotted plots of land for settlements. They were to be soldiers warding off any real and perceived enemy. This village was better described as a military camp for soldiers on peace-keeping.

This was a very proactive measure to ensure peaceful co-existence between Amokwo and all the neigbouring communities. Thanks to Amokwo Leaders of Thought led by Eze Oda Omogo (Nnanyelugo 1 of Okposhi Eshi), Chief Onwe Obashi and Chief Nwegbe Ituma who are all late. May their souls rest in Peace.

Apart from the security motives, little or no thought was given to education of the children of the settlers in this new layout. Health care was taken for granted. Water need was too much a luxury to be given a thought. Electricity can be likened to a Golden Fleece for Kings, Queens and Political Heads of Nations. So our children tracked and still track from here to Central School Ngbo a distance of about five miles to attend primary school. Health issues were left to Divine Healing when native herbs and roots failed even in emergency situations. Inhabitants dug wells to take care of water needs which hardly stand the period of dry season. When the few wells dry up in the mid of dry season, the search for water starts. Like a bear in search of water, so do we search for water to every nearby village up to the agric pond in Okotsu (popularly known as 135 damm) not less than five miles also from here or to Okpuru Umuezeaka a distance of about ten miles. During dry season as

it is now, most of the valuable hours of the day are spent in search for water. Thank God in the neat few minutes now, this experience will become a story.

Yet, one most valuable gift was given to this village. That is the gift of a piece of land dedicated for the worship of the Most High God. With time, St. Raymond Catholic Church Abegbu Amokwo where we all worshiped took the initiative to possess the land. That was when Mr. Joseph Igwe was leader. With the cooperation and support of Late. Eze Oda Omogo, the piece of land was released to the Catholic Church to build a place of worship in order to realize the dreams of those founding fathers of this village. Today, we are standing on the church named St. Joseph by Rev. Fr. David Igwe Elom the then Parish Priest of Christ Our Saviour Onu-Okwo Ngbo.

What we have come to celebrate today is God's faithfulness to that our founding father's realization to give a space where God shall be with his people. God has justified His presence amongst His people. Using His anointed minister Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo, He has given us water as, He did through Moses to the Israelites in the wilderness. Water they say is life, so God has given us life. To Him be all the Glory.

We are grateful to Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo who deliberately exposed himself to be used by God to wipe away tears from the homeless, the motherless; the less privileged the downtrodden and neglected of the societies. Indeed, societies because what we see here today have been seen and tasted by many societies across this state and beyond.

Father, if we call you Moses you are. Moses gave the Israelites water in the wilderness. You have given us water in this government forsaken area. If we call you Aaron, you are truly one. Aaron as a priest was used by God to give Divine blessing to the people. You also as an anointed priest of God not only intercede but give Divine blessing. Nobody makes any mistake if you are addressed as a Joshua. Joshua fought and worn all his battles until he led the Israelites to the promised land. You have been fighting and winning the war against hunger, thirst, poverty, discrimination of political and social class. We and others are living testimonies.

What one cannot label you is a politician. You are not one. You have not come to ask for our votes for you to win any election. That is what a politician does with empty promises to make here a heaven on earth. Tenure after tenure they come to make the proverbial promises cocks make to hens which are never fulfilled. Father you are not a politician. No, Not one.

Truly!, Truelly!!, we lack words and any known verbial expressions to tell you how grateful we are. When our people say "Ekele Enwe Eze", they are right "Oburu le ekele nweru eze, me anyi ekele ghu e I dike. I meta. Imenuka. Idebe etu.

I debe Ogadagbo" Thank you. Thank you and thank You again. The greatest thanks we know and have is our prayer to God to continue to keep you healthy, strong, wise and above all possess you always with, His spirit all the days of your life here on earth and the reward of eternal resting place at the bossom of Abraham.

At this point as humans with insatiable wants, we want to play the Oliver Twist – asking for more boreholes as earlier contained in our application.

This village is made up three settlement areas and where we are is just one. Another is close to the Ngbo School of Health Technology and the other shares a boundary with Amaogu in Oha Eku Autonomous Community.

If you look around, you will notice the efforts we are making to build a befitting worship centre to God Almighty. We wouldn't know what to ask in this direction. Whatever the Almighty lays in your heart to do concerning this, becomes our best request.

This simply means that we have people but we have only few people that can be happy and satisfied when they fellow human beings are totally emancipated from all manners of troubles and impediments. We evaluate people by what they finish, but not by what they start. And Re. Fr. Peter Omogo is such a tested and trusted man of God who promised and fulfilled.

The quest and struggle to site a borehole in Ndiaguogodo community was conceived by the leaders of the community in their bid to bring to an end the persistent suffering of our people occasioned by a severe acute scarcity of water in our area here.

A good leader is the one who feels the pulse and plight of his people and derives a possible means and mechanism to bring a total solution to such ugly menace. A good leader must be a good servant to his people as can be seen in Mark 10:42.

I must emphatically make it known to all and sundry here that during our struggle to attract a bore-hole here, we wrote to many governmental agencies and parastatals, NGOs not left out but to no avail. Then in 2018, the lole of writing to Noble Samuel Oniogo Foundation came to our naids,

many had a divergent view knowing the disappointments, promises and failures we have encountered in the hands of other NGOs. Some of us advised that there is no harm in trial and winners never quit and quitters never win. Today, the reverse is the case, we are having a successful stories to tell and we have come to realize that a day of favour is far better than 100 years of labour. And this brings about the acronym Noble attached to your name because you are NOBLE indeed

Moreover, there is no gain saying that Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation has indentified itself outstandingly among other NGOs and at the same time written its name in gold in the life history of Ndiaguogodo as a community.

Before the installation of the bore-hole here, our community was guineawarm infested area, this was as a result of non-availability of good drinking water. Our community was the only part of Ebonyi State where cows, goats, pigs and human beings drink from the same sources of water supply namely the open pond. We cannot count the number of our people that have been drowned in the Veterinary Dam which is always the only last alternative source of water whenever all the ponds must have been dried up.

Meanwhile, we the people of Ndiaguogodo community are overwhelmed with the superlative degree of love born by high level of magnanimity that you the Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation has accorded to us. Today, we have called you not to pay you back on what you did for us but to let you know how we feel, and we will ever remain grateful. According to Achebe in Things fall Apart "when a man calls his kins-men to a feast, he does not call them to save them from starvation because when moon there is compound in exemption but it is good for the kins-men to always gather". This implies that silver and gold we have none but the only thing we have is our prayer for the continuous existence of Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation.

On our own, we make a solemn promise of protecting and guarding jealously the bore-hole to see that the major aim by which it was brought to bear is not jeopardized.

REQUEST

Man will continue to want, desire and need. Infact man is insatiable in nature. Therefore, we make a passionate plea to the Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation if they can upgrade the sunk bore-hole from hand pump to motorized one. Our community is so vast that we still have other parts of the community that our people trek in miles before reaching here to fetch water and such areas still need the extension of your good work because the reward of good work is another work.

Finally, on behalf of the good people of Ndiaguogodo community, I lack words to commend you people for the honour you have bestowed on us.

However, may the Almighty God continue to bless us collectively and individually as we go to our various destinations, may the Omin-present, Omni-science and Omin-potent God continue to shower with us His blesses-Amen.

INTRODUCTION:

I am highly delighted to stand before you to read this address and to witness this great event in my life time. This is because it is like a dream come true that we will ever have drinking water in this area. Today, we are heaving a sigh of relief. To God be the Glory.

WHY WE REQUESTED FOR THE BOREHOLE

Ever since 1982 when the first man elder John Aleke Okpaga stepped into this area named after him (Ndegu Aleke), there had been scarcity of water supply. Himself and other people who joined him to live here, had to travel many kilometers in search of water to drink, cook, wash etc. People traveled to Ndulo Amoffia to fetch water from Oshisha spring, Barabara pond, Ezzangbo 135 pond, in addition to Ishinyi stream, Okwanso pond and Okpuru pond at Inyimagu Ngbo. Such water if gotten at all was very dirty to the extent that alum was added to make it clean. These lead to our people suffering from many water borne diseases such as Guinea worm, Cholera, River blindness, Diarrhea, Dysentery and other water related diseases. There were other difficulties and hardship our people also suffered as a result of scarcity of water. These include; falling sick after long trekking, hunger, or even death from the attack of some dangerous wild animas because in many cases people had to spend a night or two in order to get water or move as early as 3am or 4am in order to get good turn in the queue so

as to fetch water in time. This continued for many years before people started looking for alternative means of surviving by digging well which was not all that clean for drinking.

BENEFITS OF THE BOREHOLE

Having suffered from the above problems of scarcity of water, we sincerely hope that now that God has heard our cries and sent Moses to save His people in the person of Rev. Fr. Peter O. Omogo, we shall benefit from the borehole in the following ways:

- a. The incidences of scarcity of water will be removed
- b. Our people will stop traveling kilometers away before they could get water
- c. The cases of water borne diseases which our people suffer will now be a thing of the past
- d. The difficulties and dangers encountered from traveling a long distance to get water have been removed now.

HOW TO JEALOUSLY GUIDE THE BOREHOLE

In remembrance of our earlier sufferings for water and the effort we made in trying to attract this borehole plus the efforts of Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo, through the mercy of God, we the entire members of Ndegu Aleke village promise to look after the borehole very well in the following ways:

- 1. We shall be locking the borehole with key to stop small children from breaking or damaging it when not in use.
- 2. We shall divide the village into groups to be guarding the borehole
- 3. We shall state time of fetching the water
- 4. We shall make sure that people will always fetch the water in turns to avoid fighting which may lead to breaking it.

OUR PRAYER AND WISHES

We thank God the Almighty who through His mercies provided the water through a benevolent, patriotic, God fearing, kind hearted and philanthropic man like Rev. Fr. Peter Okweze Omogo who despite all odds decided to serve God in this direction. Our prayer and wishes is that God in His infinite mercies will protect you, guide you, bless you abundantly and grant you long life and success in all your endeavours. You shall grow from strength to strength and wisdom to wisdom Amen.

The Samuel Omogo foundation shall continue to live on, move on and fly on for alleviating the sufferings of people through the provision of borehole. May God reward you hundred folds in Jesus Name Amen.
