This bad experience always worsened at the end of every rainy season and throughout the rest of about seven (7) months, our people live in search of water.

Following the above conditions, we requested for this water from your foundation which you approved and fulfilled today. By this gesture of your foundation, it is now a reversed case. Indeed, we are happy and the level of our happiness can not be over emphasized.

Our neighbouring village; "Ndiagu Onukpa Village" seeing what you have done for us has already approached us to lead them to you for the same request to alleviate their own water problems. And we had already constituted a committee to monitor and safe guard the borehole against misuse by minors and or ill spirited individuals.

Father, your foundation are blessed and will continue to remain blessed with your friends and supporters, for God has heard the prayers of the needy which you have brought socur to their lives. We wish you good health and safe journey where ever you go.

Ladies and Gentle Men.

Good Afternoon,

On behalf of the indigenous people of Ndiagu Ishiagu I am delighted to stand before you to pure out our heartfelt joy over the assistance rendered to us by Samuel Omogo foundation. It was unbelievable when the journey started last year January, 2018. To many, it was like building castle in the air" but today it is a fulfilled reality to God's glory.

In the history of this village, water and electricity had been to us, "a never to think- about" issues but today your foundation has broken the stronghold of water poverty, yet to handle that of electricity by his grace. Water, they say is life, and indeed you have brought us life.

In December, 2017 a story was heard by one of the villagers heralding the good of Samuel Omogo foundation's philanthropic works. The villagers came and he announced to the entire village what he heard as it has been our culture here. Sequel to the announcement was a letter presented to you on the 12th January, 2018. Why we sent this letter in much a do" was the fact that we needed this water the way Egyptians needs the Nile. In the early 90s the jimmy carter foundation was to drill a borehole the same place your own is drilled but bad roads, which you summoned, could not allow when we wailed on hearing what bad news but could not help it. You suffered the same challenge(s) but owing to the fact that you believe in saving lives you did not renege.

Before now we spent our earning heavily on drugs in order to cure ourselves, wives and children from various water born diseases. But in the past few months that the borehole water is ^{our} ever source of drinking water, a lot of has been saved all because of Samuel Omogo foundation.

Giving the whole day, we cannot enunciate our benefit even in this shortest time. Our children now changed in appearances because there is

water always for them to wash their cloths and bath. So also our wives and their environment. Our domestic chores are done better with water than what it is used to be. We expunge the fear of wild animal attacking our children on our various roads while in search for water. Like I have said before, we cannot list out our benefits from this borehole in a day, even weeks. But in all, ^{without} believes it that we are the happiest village in the whole world because of God had used Samuel Omogo foundation to do for us. We because of the importance of the facility ^{has} that constitute nine men committee who will undertake the responsibility of the facility management and maintenance to ensure sustainability.



(i) It will help to eradicate if not totally but to barest minimum water born-diseases like; cholera (ii) it will help in a long way reducing the suffering of our people in search of water mostly during dry seasons like this time (iii) more so, it has provided us with sure source of drinking water. The borehole is one of good things that had happened to us in recent past, in this village

The preservation and maintenance of the borehole: one of the major reasons for citing it at the church compound was for proper care and oversight. As it is in the church compound, the Minister is always there to monitor the usage and to lock it when necessary. Even though it is in the church compound it does not mean it is for the church alone, the church will serve it's purpose.

APPRECIATION: Once again we appreciate God for His mercy in making today a reality. We also appreciate the "God-sent" of Ngbo – The Samuel Omogo Foundation, the director Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo for their kind gesture towards this community (Obomalegu). We also appreciate Rt. Rev. Elom who took the bold step in meeting Rev. Fr. Omogo, may God continue to bless you for us in Jesus name. we equally appreciate all who come to celebrate with us, we say thank you for making today a success.

Anyagharigwe Community in Azuebonyi Umunwagu Idembia, Ezza South L-GA

ADDRESS OF WELCOME PRESENTED AT THE COMMISSIONING CEREMONY OF WATER WELL (BOREHOLE) INSTALLED BY SAMUEL OMOAGO FOUNDATION (SOF).

On behalf of Anyagharigwe community, Chief Alo Boniface Nwobasi (aka Alhaji) and my family, I wish to welcome you all to the commissioning ceremony of this wonderful borehole drilled by **Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF)** which will ameliorate the suffering of the people of this community through our daughter Mrs Igwe Rosemary Ozioma. This is a very important event in the history of Anyagharigwe community in Azuebonyi Umunwagu Idembia, Ezza South Local Government Area of Ebonyi State.

It is indeed a thing of great joy to see all of us gathered here today, to thank God for His blessings on our community and to pray for His continued favour on **Rev Fr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo** and SOF in years to come. Thank you for making out time from your busy schedule to share in our celebration this afternoon. I know many of you, including priests and friends, had to rearrange your schedules so that you could be here to share in our joy. For honouring us with your presence, we are truly grateful.

The Scripture says "With the Lord, a thousand years is like a day" (2 Peter 3:8). Fifty years is but a twinkling of an eye in God's time, but it is a long time by human reckoning; especially when we consider all that we have being through. Many of our children and wives lost their lives due to lack of clean accessible water to our people. In 2002 my kid brother (**Izuchukwu, may his soul rest in peace----AMEN**) was drowned in the river in an attempt to fetch water. In 2015 so many of our children and adults died as a result of cholera, my mother escaped the colds hands of death by the grace of God during that 2015 cholera outbreak and other countless of lives lost due to lack of clean water during that episode. **Rev Fr Peter Omogo** noted in one of his commissioning that "One can do without good roads; one can do without electricity but cannot do without water because it is life". Thank you for giving life to my people

Rev Fr., Peter Okwoeze Omogo is a priest of Roman Catholic Church, so many of us have heard about him through the media due to numerous philanthropic work he has done and still doing to the people of Ebonyi State especially vulnerable communities like ours who have being partly forgotten by the government during developmental projects. Through him, SOF have drilled over two hundred and fifth (250) boreholes to the people of Ebonyi state. Each borehole provides clean water to over fifty (50) household and each household is made up of minimum of ten (10) persons. Institutions like schools, churches both catholic and non catholic are not left out as they have also benefited immensely from SOF. He has not worked here as a parish priest, hence so many of us may not know him in person but he is a good friend of one of our beloved parish priest emeritus **Rev. Fr Samuel Ituma**.

Provision of safe and accessible water supply to the rural communities is one of the most socio-economic and developmental necessity required for improvement of life. Ebonyi State government has made some efforts to provide boreholes in a number of communities but Anagharigwe has never being lucky to access any. Our people are only remembered by government during elections. Therefore we thank the Almighty God for SOF who remembered us and this is not only commendable but will be properly documented in the history of this great community.

Anagharigwe is a village in Umunwagu Idembia community with a population of over two thousand (2000) persons whose source of water before this day was surface water. The inhabitant of this community trek long distances to obtain water and the main source of water are streams and ponds which are hardly safe for human consumption and even dries up during the onset of dry season. During the dry season members of this community trek for over a kilometer to Ebonyi River to get water. Women and children are always vulnerable to snake bites, fighting and other social vices as they leave very early in the morning to fetch water before it gets contaminated from chemicals and diets from cloth washing. The members of this community constantly experience outbreak of water borne diseases like dysentery, typhoid fever, cholera, etc which have claimed lots of lives. This also affected the quality of education in this community as school children go to school late or even skip school due to time spent in the stream or the only borehole in the neighbouring community. Some children and even adults have being drowned in the river in their quest to fetch water from less contaminated areas. Late chief **Boniface Alo (aka Alhaji) (May His Gentile Soul Rest In Perfect Peace--AMEN)** had to dig Water Well in his compound after the death of his second son who was drowned in Ebonyi River in an attempt to fetch water. This well is always accessed by his close neighbours but serves limited households during the dry season.

Today we have gathered here to kick-start the end of water scarcity to the people of Anagharigwe through this great foundation and our people are really grateful to the donors and sponsors of this noble foundation. I would like to express my profound gratitude to the chief executive officer of SOF in the person of **Rev Fr Peter Okwoeze Omogo** and other board members of this great foundation who made this event possible. You have really lived your philosophy of life "Life without a legacy is a fruitless life" in this community and this will be guarded jealously with everything within our power. We really pray for more water wells from SOF to ameliorate the suffering of our community to a greater extent

May God continue to bless and protect this noble foundation and to the chief executive officer, God will continue to favour you in all that you do.

We welcome you to Enyanwuigwe, Ndebor Odeligbo Okpuitumo and are glad to see the faces of those who graciously put smiles on our faces, put water in our drinking pots, provided water for our cooking, saved us from thirst and diseases, washed our clothes and cleaned up our bodies. We warmly say welcome and may God bless you.

This village and indeed the entire Okpuitumo community is one of the most neglected and abandoned by the political class. This village lacks completely social amenities such as hospital, electricity and potable water. As at the time of appealing to your Foundation, the entire village of about four square kilometers had no functional source of water except the motorized borehole here in my compound for domestic use. Due to paucity of funds, there was hardly enough diesel to reticulate the water in sufficient quantity. The people traveled long distances in search of water only to come back carrying dirty water not fit for use. In addition to the already crushing poverty, the people had to struggle to pay bills for treatment of water borne disease and only God can keep the figures of those who have lost their lives in such disease.

The drilling of this hand pump borehole has come to remedy the deficiencies of the motorized borehole formerly available to the people while keeping in close view, the prospect of boosting the available solar power to assist the diesel plant in reticulating the water from the motorized borehole. The availability of the motorized borehole will help to elongate the services of the hand pump thus ensuring that the people will have abundant supply of water for a long time to come. The facility will be well guarded not just due to the location, but, also my personal readiness to regularly maintain it by replacing worn-out parts and overhauling it whenever necessary.

While we are aware that the prayers from the altar of God cover your need, we will not fail to ask God to add more blessings to you. We pray that as many as there are people benefiting from the water project and as long as the benefits last, so will your blessings be multiplied and remain enduring.

Truly, water is life. You have touched our lives by the provision of potable water. We do not have anything as big as life to give in appreciation. We are peasant farmers here but we cannot fail to give you our hearts which are overrunning with gratitude. Accept this little token from us as mere symbol of what we feel for you in our hearts.

Finally, we know you are close to the altar and so we ask you to continue to pray for all of us in this poor village. We assure you too of our prayer for the progress of your noble Foundation hoping that as you grow in the future, our village and others will have more shares of the benefits from it. Thank you dear father Peter and may God bless your team.

Today is a special day in the lives of all the good people of Ndiaguogodo who have trouped out in their big numbers to sing words of praises and appreciation to God for the good work done to them through Noble Samuel Amogo Foundation spear-headed by our illustrious son, a Rev. by birth and by inclination, Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo. This humanitarian gesture is a prove that there are eggs and their eggs, there are kings and there are kings, and kings are greater than kings. This simply means that we have people but we have only few people that can be happy and satisfied when they fellow human beings are totally emancipated from all manners of troubles and impediments. We evaluate people by what they finish, but not by what they start. And Re. Fr. Peter Omogo is such a tested and trusted man of God who promised and fulfilled.

The quest and struggle to site a borehole in Ndiaguogodo community was conceived by the leaders of the community in their bid to bring to an end the persistent suffering of our people occasioned by a severe acute scarcity of water in our area here.

A good leader is the one who feels the pulse and plight of his people and derives a possible means and mechanism to bring a total solution to such ugly menace. A good leader must be a good servant to his people as can be seen in Mark 10:42.

I must emphatically make it known to all and sundry here that during our struggle to attract a bore-hole here, we wrote to many governmental agencies and parastatals, NGOs not left out but to no avail. Then in 2018, the idea of writing to Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation came to our minds, 1

many had a divergent view knowing the disappointments, promises and failures we have encountered in the hands of other NGOs. Some of us advised that there is no harm in trial and winners never quit and quitters never win. Today, the reverse is the case, we are having a successful stories to tell and we have come to realize that a day of favour is far better than 100 years of labour. And this brings about the acronym Noble attached to your name because you are NOBLE indeed

Moreover, there is no gain saying that Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation has indentified itself outstandingly among other NGOs and at the same time written its name in gold in the life history of Ndiaguogodo as a community.

Before the installation of the bore-hole here, our community was guinea-warm infested area, this was as a result of non-availability of good drinking water. Our community was the only part of Ebonyi State where cows, goats, pigs and human beings drink from the same sources of water supply namely the open pond. We cannot count the number of our people that have been drowned in the Veterinary Dam which is always the only last alternative source of water whenever all the ponds must have been dried up.

Meanwhile, we the people of Ndiaguogodo community are overwhelmed with the superlative degree of love born by high level of magnanimity that you the Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation has accorded to us. Today, we have called you not to pay you back on what you did for us but to let you know how we feel, and we will ever remain grateful. According to Achebe in Things fall Apart "when a man calls his kins-men to a feast, he does not call them to save them from starvation because when moon there is compound in exemption but it is good for the kins-men to always gather". This implies that silver and gold we have none but the only thing we have is our prayer for the continuous existence of Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation.

On our own, we make a solemn promise of protecting and guarding jealously the bore-hole to see that the major aim by which it was brought to bear is not jeopardized.

REQUEST

Man will continue to want, desire and need. Infact man is insatiable in nature. Therefore, we make a passionate plea to the Noble Samuel Omogo Foundation if they can upgrade the sunk bore-hole from hand pump to motorized one. Our community is so vast that we still have other parts of the community that our people trek in miles before reaching here to fetch water and such areas still need the extension of your good work because the reward of good work is another work.

Finally, on behalf of the good people of Ndiaguogodo community, I lack words to commend you people for the honour you have bestowed on us.

However, may the Almighty God continue to bless us collectively and individually as we go to our various destinations, may the Omin-present, Omni-science and Omin-potent God continue to shower with us His blessings- Amen.

This bad experience always worsened at the end of every rainy season and throughout the rest of about seven (7) months, our people live in search of water.

Following the above conditions, we requested for this water from your foundation which you approved and fulfilled today. By this gesture of your foundation, it is now a reversed case. Indeed, we are happy and the level of our happiness can not be over emphasized.

Our neighbouring village; "Ndiagu Onukpa Village" seeing what you have done for us has already approached us to lead them to you for the same request to alleviate their own water problems. And we had already constituted a committee to monitor and safe guard the borehole against misuse by minors and or ill spirited individuals.

Father, your foundation are blessed and will continue to remain blessed with your friends and supporters, for God has heard the prayers of the needy which you have brought socur to their lives. We wish you good health and safe journey where ever you go.

To this effect, our village Ogbanike people have to travel about ten (10) Kilometers to fetch water from Okpuru pond and Ishinyi stream at another village.

To eradicate this ugly, condition which get worst during the dry season, individuals who are privileged to afford the cost decided to dig water wells in their homes while so many families which cannot afford the cost of digging a well are left at the mercy of their neighborhood. Even the wells so dug by families do not stand the test of time and so, some of the wells dry up on or before the dry season and the villagers depend on dirty ponds as their only source of water.

Ogbanike village had been subjected to various problems occasioned by this scarcity of drinkable water thus;

- ✓ Our people especially women and children contact avoidable diseases such as guinea worm, dysentery, cholera etc.
- ✓ Our children absent themselves from school or go late to school as a result of long trek in search of water.
- ✓ Our children who go from one place to another in search of water are prone to embarrassment from unsuspecting criminals who beat our children.

- ✓ Our economic programs especially agricultural activities are deteriorated because of inadequate irrigation.

Consequent upon the above predicaments, we appealed to Samuel Omogo Foundation (S.O.F) in January, 2018, seeking for her intervention for providing the borehole for the village. On November, 2018 the borehole was drilled by Samuel Omogo Foundation (S.O.F).

As this borehole is being commissioned today, 15th January, 2019, we express our immense gratitude to Almighty God who made it possible for us to have a borehole.

We appreciate you Rev. Father Peter Omogo a philanthropist of first order for having brought succor to so many citizens of not only Ngbo clan but entire Ebonyi State.

A big thanks to our amiable, unshakable, God fearing and unquenchable transformer, Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo "Nwakibe".


