2. The families within and outside the school use the water for drinking, for washing, for domestic activities and other things.



Therefore, the borehole (water well) has helped to stop the scarcity of water within the school and its environment. It has also helped to solve the problems of water during the dry season.

According to the book of Ecclesiastes chapter 3:4, there is a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance. Indeed, this wonderful day has brought a turn around in the history and lives of our people and Amaeffia in general. From the beginning, Ndiagu Ogbobule Village in Amaeffia was like abandoned project over water issue. The village has suffered a lot of abuses and disgrace as it regards water supply, our dear Rev. Fr. Dr., you may wish to know that before now that this village, Ndiagu ogbobule village named after ogbobule stream, was a pitiable village. The village that depended on ogbobule stream, Ifu Ikepete Pond, Obvu Nwaegbali Pond and okpuru Amaeffia as their major sources of water supply. This has given rise to water born disease such as cholera, guinea worn, typhoid fever to mention but a few. We have lost many precious lives as a result of afore mentioned water borne diseases. The worst of it all is that those streams and ponds which the village depend on as sources of water supply dry up as early as November every year. The villagers travel 15-20km inside the bush in search of water. In most of those places we go in search of water, our women and girls has been exposed to sexual abuse and most of the times, the owners of such water bodies usually display their masquerades in the name of watching over their water bodies and those masquerades usually pursue us, thereby scaring us away and denying us of water.

It was in the cause of our lamentation and grieved expression on a facial appearance that people who benefited from the welfare scheme of Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF), now referred us to Rev.Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo. Like a hungry lion, we hurriedly rushed to the house of referred Rev. Fr. Dr. It was like a joke on that wonderful and glorious day, when Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo came down from his house to meet us and after going through our application and expression form, he told us to go and take it to God in prayers. He

also promised to reach us as soon as possible. Oh! What a priest sent by God to deliver us from water slavery? Today it is a reality.

Like Moses who led the Israelites out of Egypt, **Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo** sent borehole drillers, who brought glad tidings to us on that 20th December, 2019. Our joys were beyond expression when the drilling exercise started. Unfortunately to us on that day our joy turned into sorrow because there was no water seen. We all wept like little children. Thank God because the drillers told us that there is hope for the hopeless. Today, it is a time for us to rejoice and jubilate for God has used **Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF)** to wipe away all our tears. We are no more laughing stock among the neighbouring villages and communities. Something good has come out of Nazareth.

The priest of the most High God, we owe you nothing but prayers that God will bless you and your mission.

Let me summarize this address with the words of John Wesley who says that "he (**Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo**) did all the good he can, by all the means he can, in all ways he can, in all the places he can, at all the time he can, to all the people he can, as long as ever he can". To God be the glory.



Ladies and gentlemen, please permit me to use this wonderful opportunity given, to first appreciate God Almighty, The Alpha and Omega, The Beginning and End, The Hope for the hopeless, The Portion of our Inheritance, The Builder of all things, You are so kind to us, we say thank you.

With a full heart of joy, may I on behalf of the Enyioma village and Oshiegbe community welcome every one present in this great event. Today is a remarkable day and the history of this village can never be completed without reflecting on today's event; The first of its kind to attract social Amenity from any agency, both Gov't and non-governmental agency, with the cost of no price to achieve, but through a life touching Catholic priest Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Omogo.

With reference, we heard about your foundation through the St. Jude Parish Catechist Onunweke, Bro. Ignetus Nwamgbabu on Feb. 10th 2019 during drought season when our villagers went to their village for a safe drinking water.

We summoned ourselves at this venue and followed his directives with an application letter and a sample of ten people from our population to see you at your residential home Ngbo. Despite the challenge we encountered on our way going, but the manifestation today was a sign of victory.

Today! Our dream came true, we say thank you very much, words are not enough to express our feeling, but the only way to pay you back are to;

- (1). Pray for God's guidance and protection always,
- (2). Pray for God to give you power and sound health to continue His work of evangelism through your foundation,
- (3) Put what we achieved during workshop into practice and finally remain faithful to God and a good Catholic Christian.

Our people are facing serious health challenge as a result of water borne diseases such as cholera, diarrhea and typhoid which are contacted through a contaminated water from the stream, ponds, and rainy water as the only available water source in our locality, but today, the story has changed through Samuel Omogo Foundation. The borehole sunk will not only eradicate untimely death in our village, but will also encourage our school aged children to be punctual to school and our people to attend their schedule on time without wasting much of their time searching for water, no more 3 km distance every season for safe drinking water again.

RECOMMENDATIONS

This occasion drew marmots crowded from within and outside the state to grace the occasion. I was indeed privileged to witness it live at Abarigwe Primary School Umuogudu Osha, Ngbo. Everyone who graced the occasion smiled home with different packages. The ten students who smiled home with brand new Laptops are still counting their blessings. As number one philanthropist priest in the history of Abakaliki Diocese you have blessed uncountable number of people. Once again, congratulations, bravo and more feathers to your cap.

SOF was created in 2012 with a major objective of fostering the responsible development of clean water sources for villages in Southeast Nigeria. The foundation have accomplished their major objectives as she has drilled over 300 water well in different parts of the state thereby providing clean water to over 200,000 Ebonyians of which our village have benefitted from.

Let me state it here that Rev Fr Dr. Peter Omogo is a "miracle worker", you may ask how so? Yes, a monk once asked a holy man: How can we perform miracles? The holy Saint answered: "If you teach a person to read the Gospel, you have opened the eyes of the blind. If you teach a person to help the needy, you have healed the paralyzed. If you lead

someone to repentance, you have raised the dead. Now go and perform miracles". In Rev Fr. Dr Peter Omogo, these became realities; he did all those and many more. He opened the eyes of his flock to see that the bright future they dreamt of is only feasible through adequate health and quality education. **Water is life**, for giving people water he has given life and there is no greater miracle than **LIFE**. In this world where acquisition of property or money is the dominant motive, you have denied yourself lots of comfort in fulfillment of your being "Leaving legacies" mostly in humanitarian services. Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter O. Omogo words are not adequate to express our profound gratitude to you. Long before now we trek between 10- 15km under the scorching sun to fetch water from Ebonyi River which is not even clean as people wash and even defecate inside. Occasionally this river had drowned women and children who went to fetch and bath in the river. This village equally shares boundary with a community in land dispute and this has claimed countless number of lives in search of water. This lead to the villagers settling for pond stagnated water. In 2015, over ten persons here lost their lives to cholera outbreak. The provision of this water well has reduced the suffering of our people and also improved our standard of living.

We wish to bring to your notice that over 200 house hold depends on this water and each house contains minimum of 7 persons. This implies that over 1,400 persons depend on this water well excluding our neighbouring community Oshiri which is less than 2km away. On this note we sincerely request for more water wells to improve our lives.

OUR JOURNEY TO UMUOGUDU OSHIA

After a deep thoughtful consideration and decision to try our chances, on the 11th of January 2018/2019, respectively we went to Umuogudu Oshia to see this great philanthropist (Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo). On arrival, we were almost frustrated when we saw a crowd of people/groups waiting for the same

purpose, but the God of Ndiagu Elom granted us favour in the sight of Rev. Fr. Dr. Omogo who on sighting on us beckoned on us to come, as we went in with him and came out with a promise^w that ^e have been considered for 2019 sometime in August, some men came in search of a spot where the borehole can be drilled. When they came they find water the first day, we thanked God who is the owner of water two months after, those men came back, and to our greatest surprise, they could not get the water in the spot. Like Christians waiting for the coming of the lord Jesus, we waited patiently for the appointed time. Like those who dreamt^e, then on the 22nd January 2020, we were called upon to come to Okwor Ngbo market to direct those coming to do the job, with no time wasted we saw the heavy equipment moved into this compound and our joy knew no bound.

As a community, we call upon the God that brought us into existence, who divinely made this conglomerate possible to nourish you with every good thing that the land can produce. it is our collective prayer that this N.G.O. who which started like a mustard seed will grow into a giant tree that will provide shield for many birds, a sought out tree by many for its curing efficacy, a balm of Gilead that runs like a stream of water, flowing across communities, states and even nations. We pray that the life of this Solomon who never asked for the head of his enemies, a man who places the interest of his people above his own personal interest be long and filled with an increased Grace to continue this good work he has started. Yes we can manage life without good roads, we can live without electricity, we can manage rickety cars and houses but no one can manage life without water because water is life, and you have given us life without^{through} the provision of this portable^{clean} clean water.

2. The families within and outside the school use the water for drinking, for washing, for domestic activities and other things.


Therefore, the borehole (water well) has helped to stop the scarcity of water within the school and its environment. It has also helped to solve the problems of water during the dry season.







We really know that you have favoured so many lives, gifts and talents are God's endowment on man which are natural or arise as a result of training and commitment. Your spiritual gifts that are purely the acts of the Holy Spirit alleviated the suffering of the most basic need of man to survive as a living organism. We know your banner over us is love.

Meanwhile, our profound gratitude goes to God almighty who preserved your life throughout your educational pursuit in the western world and also to your doggedness, commitment cum your social relationship with the Americans. 

- (ii) Urubi stream and Okpuru Odo will cease to drown children
- (iii) There will be no exchange of words' fights as people will be fetching water easier.
- (iv) Domestic animals will have enough water to drink.

The Directors and his entourage, members of the high table, the members of the village have the following plans to maintain the bore hole for optimum operation.

- (1) Proper supervision by the village bore hole committee.
- (2) Children under age will not be allowed to draw water from the bore hole
- (3) The bore hole will be locked after use both in the morning and evening.
- (4) Anybody caught defecating within the premises will be sanctioned.
- (5) Water containers will be lined up as the owners wait for their turn.

water problems testifies that you are the Daniel that has come to judgment. More grease to your elbows!


Father, this borehole cited here at Ogbagede shows that you are the hope of the abandoned and you are loving and caring. May the Almighty Father reward you abundantly.



Indeed, this wonderful day has brought a turn around in the history and lives of our people and Amaeffia in general. From the beginning, Ndiagu Ogbobule Village in Amaeffia was like abandoned project over water issue. The village has suffered a lot of abuses and disgrace as it regards water supply, our dear Rev. Fr. Dr., you may wish to know that before now that this village, Ndiagu ogbobule village named after ogbobule stream, was a pitiable village. The village that depended on ogbobule stream, Ifu Ikepete Pond, Obvu Nwaegbali Pond and okpuru Amaeffia as their major sources of water supply. This has given rise to water born disease such as cholera, guinea worn, typhoid fever to mention but a few. We have lost many precious lives as a result of afore mentioned water borne diseases. The worst of it all is that those streams and ponds which the village depend on as sources of water supply dry up as early as November every year. The villagers travel 15-20km inside the bush in search of water. In most of those places we go in search of water, our women and girls has been exposed to sexual abuse and most of the times, the owners of such water bodies usually display their masquerades in the name of watching over their water bodies and those masquerades usually pursue us, thereby scaring us away and denying us of water.

It was in the cause of our lamentation and grieved expression on a facial appearance that people who benefited from the welfare scheme of Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF), now referred us to Rev.Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo. Like a hungry lion, we hurriedly rushed to the house of referred Rev. Fr. Dr. It was like a joke on that wonderful and glorious day, when Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo came down from his house to meet us and after going through our application and expression form, he told us to go and take it to God in prayers. He

also promised to reach us as soon as possible. Oh! What a priest sent by God to deliver us from water slavery? Today it is a reality.

Like Moses who led the Israelites out of Egypt, **Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo** sent borehole drillers, who brought glad tidings to us on that 20th December, 2019. Our joys were beyond expression when the drilling exercise started. Unfortunately to us on that day our joy turned into sorrow because there was no water seen. We all wept like little children. Thank God because the drillers told us that there is hope for the hopeless. Today, it is a time for us to rejoice and jubilate for God has used **Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF)** to wipe away all our tears. We are no more laughing stock among the neighbouring villages and communities. Something good has come out of Nazareth.

The priest of the most High God, we owe you nothing but prayers that God will bless you and your mission.

Let me summarize this address with the words of John Wesley who says that “he (**Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Okwoeze Omogo**) did all the good he can, by all the means he can, in all ways he can, in all the places he can, at all the time he can, to all the people he can, as long as ever he can”. To God be the glory.






