This scarcity of water has prompted many people to trek to Akpaka stream to fetch water more especially during dry season, and most times when fetched will not be clean and safe for drinking. This has so far caused so many water borne diseases which has lasted for a couple of years, and to solve these problems different families started digging water wells, which also has its short-comings, as many people could not afford the money to dig well, and when dug the water will still not be neat and safe for consumption. On different occasions, many people have made effort to call attention of Government to this plight but to no avail.

However during the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration of **Rev. Fr. Omogo**, the brochure indicated over 60 borehole dug by the **Samuel Omogo Foundation**. This prompted us to complain to the foundation about the scarcity of water in Ndiagu Ode Villages and in his usually manner listened and came to our aid, at this right time.

So let's give him **five gbosaa**-----!

Rev. Fr. Peter Okwor –Eze Omogo has been not just a spiritual gladiator but a benefactor who has touched the lives of many people. In diverse ways, through **Samuel Omogo Foundation**, many lives have been touched positively, which we are lucky to be not just witness to, but partakers of.

This borehole which will be commissioned today will be a good source of water to the whole village. And from today both the entire village and the nearby villages have seen an end to water scarcity and water borne diseases that has been a major concern for years. **PROTOCOL**

The basic needs of man are water, shelter and clothing though the most important of these needs is water. This is because water is life as it is virtually used in every human activity. However, in spite of its importance, its scarcity has become an endemic problem for decades and the world's leading problems affecting more than 1.1 billion people globally, meaning that one in every six people lacks access to safe drinking water.

The Joint Monitoring Programme for Water Supply and Sanitation set-up by the World Health Organization (WHO) and United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) defines safe drinking water as "water with microbial, chemical and physical characteristics that meets World Health Organization (WHO) guidelines or National standards on drinking water quality". As of 2006, one third of all nations suffered from clean water scarcity which the people of Ndufu Alike, Ikwo and Ebonyi State in general were not left behind.

At this juncture, permit me to say that Ebonyi state was formerly notorious as guinea-worm endemic area which was as a result of lack of potable/clean water. In order to prevent the outbreak of water borne diseases such as cholera, the University Management approached Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo through Barr. G.O Eze-Ali to sink a borehole for her through **Samuel Omogo Foundation**. This is because Fr. Omogo has executed similar projects not only in Ikwo but throughout Abakaliki Zone in particular

Thank you all for coming and joining us today.

We are pleased to be able to welcome those of you who are indigenes, and in a special way, our visitors, some of whom are coming to this community for the first time today. You are most welcome to Onuafor village, Ezzama community. Oshi adu ooo! Unu tokwehu.

The Issue of water scarcity has remained an age-long problem for our people, especially for those who live in this side of the village. This is due to the fact that the only portable (though not always accessible) source of water arround here is the bore-hole situated at the Afor Market square which barely serves the people living close to it as it ceases to function annually at some point during the dry season. The other alternative is Ebonyi River which is few kilometres away from here.

As a result of the water scarcity experienced by our people, we are forced to drink low quality water from flowing streams, many of which are containuinated, and mosquitoes and other insects breed on these dirty water bodies. The result is deadly MALARIA and other dangerous infections. Also, less water means that farm crops that need water to grow have low yields. This means that farm animals die and others not do well without water. The consequences of this are constant hunger, thirst and low quality of life. Furthermore, access to quality water is key to economic prosperity and better living standards. Business and schools thrive when people come to work on time and not have to spend all morning looking for water. Lack of water means little or no economic activities happen and as such, our people have been in constant poverty.

I first heard of Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF) from comrade Williams Obiya, even before I learned of their alliance with Rotary club, Abakaliki District. With my knowledge of the foundation and her good works, I contacted

few persons who sent help which resulted in the bore-hole we have in our community and which is being commissioned today, to the glory of God. As evidenced by the drillings of this bore-hole and other countless good works of the foundation, it is obvious that God has moved to ameliorate the very many sufferings of our people through Samuel Omogo Foundation (SOF).

Most of us especially the Youths, knew Fr. Peter Omogo way back when he was the chaplain of Abakaliki Diocesan Bloc Rosary crusade.

Though he traveled abroad at some point, he has always been a man of many parts who takes so much joy in helping others. Like I once explained on George Umeh's wall on Facebook, he acts out his surname, Omogo (Ome +Ogo) which means a philanthropist. Thus it obvious that we have always known him and felt his positive impact in our lives.

With the complection of this bore-hole, Fr. Omogo has seriously lessened our burden; he's given us a new lease of life. We now have access to protable water and that means a new dawn for our people. By drilling this bore-hole for us, Fr. Peter has curred our malaria and even other terrible diseases like guinea worm and the likes. He has made it posible for our farm crops to have higher yield and for our business to thrive. For these and many more, we are immensely grateful

For this your kind gesture to us and for the very many other beautiful constribution of yours to the good of humanity Fr. Peter Omogo, we pray that you walk and never stumble. May your days be long and prosperous. May all your good dream come to fulfilment. It shall be well with you all.

**EFFIUKWU: A BRIEF BACKGROUND**

The name Effiukwu denotes a big, habitable bush where trees and grasses, wild and low animals, and later all classes of people harbour. Effiukwu, as a village in a country side, is populated with over five thousand people but lacked/lacks basic amenities like electricity, portable road and water, bridges and culverts, schools, churches and markets, including working and educational conditions, hampering general good health and comfort of the people. These had secluded the villagers as those in a cave as there were only two options for living since water is life:

1. to fetch dirty and impure water from Ishiogwe, Ohuba, Ogba Ikwe, or Mkpuma Aturu Ikwe streams after wasting much period of time or
2. Trek a very far distance to Ebenyi River, spending hours to and fro.

Consequently, the effects of water borne diseases and the consequent difficulties on the people can better be imagined than expressed. Guinea worm, typhoid, dysentery, cholera and other water borne diseases, plagued most of the villagers and even choked life out of many in the prime of their lives.

Take a flash back at some years ago, after **Rev. Fr's** Promise and advice about the bore hole when we visited him and made a request. It had seemed to us a fruitless fantasy as time after time passed and the promise was not fast coming. As we continued to ASK, Asking, Seeking, and Knocking, we were directed to request to the head Rotary Foundation, in line with a phone call received some time in **November, 2016** regarding the bore hole project. Seemingly a fruitless fantasy still, time went and we wondered and kept faith until we could sing joyous songs of praises against our previous cries of pains.

Indeed, there are three categories of people in every society: those who make things happen, those who watch things happen, and those who do not even notice things when they happen. Our illustrious son, brother, uncle and friend belongs to the first category of people for raising money for charity, dedicating his life and time helping those in need. **Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo** the man who God has given special inspiration and so devoted greater part of his life, giving life to the dejected-forgetting his materialistic tendencies – leaving self that other selves could live.

In fact, we lack words to express our state of mind as our joy knows no bound. We only pray that God repay you and all agents that put forces and efforts together to see the dream come true.

Mater-of-factly, the bore holes built for the community have bettered the lots of the villagers and the neighbourhood in the short period of time. The villagers have forgotten the pains of trekking far and wide to Ebenyi River, forfeiting other valued engagement. Ravaging water borne diseases have become stories of the past and special thanks to **Rev. Fr. Omogo and his rescue team** for changing our story to His glory!.

We cannot thank God enough for our revered golden gentleman, but like Oliver Twist, we pray God to raise more people-people who are turned off and dissatisfied with the world of self - people who are wholly devoted – their lives, times, tides, names, fames, moments and money – to put a balanced world.

Lastly, our gratitude goes to all the sons and daughters of Effiukwu, with special regards to **Rt. Insp. Ede Benard**, the **Chairman Effiukwu Welfare Association** and entire members, **Mr. Agbo John**, the **chairman bore hole committee and team**, the **youths, women**, and our wonderful **dancing troop**, not leaving everybody who contributed one way or the other to see the project come to reality.

Finally, we promise to take care of the bore holes, protect against vandals of whichever manner, asking God to lead you back homes after this joyous stay in Jesus' Name, Amen!

We the members of the village wish (SOF) Divine blessing, support and success in all their endeavours/undertakings.





Frankly speaking dry season have been one of those days we never wish to come, due to scarcity of water in the village, one have to leave some gallons , barrels and other things used for fetching water at the stream waiting for his/her turn to fetch water from the small hole in the stream that brings out little water, one can stay for the whole day and later come home with one gallon or without water because of this our people have device the means of saving or storing rain water which after some day produces lava and later become mosquito, some take their bath once a day while some once in two days and even fail to do some domestic work due to scarcity of water and diseases it brings to the village.

Due to scarcity of good water in our village, our people both home and abroad have been searching for the means of getting bore-hole and searching for Samuel Omogo foundation for help because we have had the beneficiaries testifying and rejoicing for Rev. Fr. Peter Omogo's hand in their life, so we too have equally needed his help. On one faithfully day in 2017 date not remembered our brother Ominyi Godwin brought the Samuel

Omogo foundation form to the community, having scarcity of water, our chairman Mr. Eze Kenneth and some members of the community did their best to fill and comply to the directive of the form while our chairman told us that Rev. Fr. Omogo said we should put it in the hand of God.
