As we are having a sign of relieve today through the installation of the bore hole this of course is bring to an end the problem of water scarcity and has added series of stories of what we shall tell the new generation to come. These

were the good works of our dear Rev. Father, a father whose love is unconditional, a father whose generosity and gesture do not only portray practical Christianity but also a challenge to Nigerians, Christians especially those who are in the position to help but could not due to unpatriotic attitude, instead of helping to alleviate the suffering of the masses even administers salt in our injuries.

We lack words to express our gratitude but we are saying BRAVO. Neither Silver nor Gold do we have, but thanks.

As we had earlier stated that Unity Church is made of members from different villages, we, like Oliver Twist need some more anytime it is available. We promise to take appropriate care of bore hole.

We have no silver nor gold all we have is thank you. We pray that the good Lord who we serve will continue to replenish all your good deeds abundantly and in geometric progression. We wish to assure you that haven attended and certificated the two-days Samuel Omogo foundation wash training workshop on hygiene and sanitation promotion we will abound by all the directives given to preserve and maintain the borehole. After this training, we have lunched operation no open defecation in our village. We promise to abide by all the directives given.



According to Chuk Feeney "we need to make generosity a part of our lives: it is not only about giving money but much more about freely and



Today the story has changed and has become one of the happiest day in the history of Ndiagu-Uzhi people in Umuoru as one of the illustrious sons and one of the spiritual leaders of Ohaukwu Local Government Area of Ebonyi State has established a foundation known as Samuel Omogo Foundation in honour of Rev. Fr. Dr. Peter Omogo which is targeted to drilling boreholes across Ebonyi State and beyond just to alleviate the peoples sufferings on clean water accessibility which the people of ndiagu-Uzhi in Umuoru is today one of the beneficiaries.

Sir, your magnanimity in squeezing time out of your tight schedule is an indication of your unflinching love for the people of Umuoru. It is also a mark of your commitment to the welfare of your people and to Umuoru people in particular. 

This is as a result that we do not have bore hole in our village. The only one build by one politician in our play ground (Edukwu Mitte) many years ago used to dry up before November ending yearly. Without the help of Okpuru Eji water pond and Okpuru Idike water pond, Ndukabyi village has no other water source, except we go to other villages for water supply.



It is notable that human survival is dependent mostly on water, thus the commissioning of this borehole has multi-facet benefit as it supports balance economic development.


Presently, the Cathedral have two number boreholes but only one produces water that contains less contamination which is being used by our priest and residents of the cathedral.

In the history of people of Ndiokpuru village in Inyimagu, Okoshi Eheku community, today will ever remains unforgettable and memorable. The sufferings of this particular village over a years in search of drinking water cannot be explained. Father, you may know that apart from the fact that our health situation is mostly caused by so many disease associated with bad water system.

Our people also suffered a lot of inhuman, cruel and sadistic threats from neighboring communities and villages, just in search of good drinking water. Just to mention but a few; unknown people will always hide in the bush in order to snatch our bucket and cans, some of our girls are been raped and our children got lost. As a result of the above bad things that happen, we discovered high number of death rate and unwanted pregnancy.

We experienced a relieve from the above ugly incident mentioned above in the year 2018 when the first Borehole by Samuel Omogo foundation was drilled at a nearby village Ndi-Uroko Inyimagu. We say that a savior has come, but little we don't know that our problem was not over. Reason be that the only borehole

available was not serving about four different villages around us and it was over crowded with people.

Though, the people controlling the borehole was offering a fire service everybody, but the crowd was so much to the point that some people will not fetch water for up to three or four hours in a day and some will not be able to fetch even once or twice in a week of 7 days (can you imagine). The unfair situation almost pushed us back to the former water state. But we thank God today for giving a helper to us.

Father, I wish to say that the benefits of this borehole will not be written in one note book. Before now, our people use to travel about 15 to 20km inside the bush I search of water, not only that the journey is far but it is full of risky of life, more especially now that bad boys is everywhere. With the help of the borehole, our lives are safe and more secured. History cannot be forgotten with the with the victory over sufferings was achieved by God through our dearly Rev. Father Peter Okwoeze Omogo. We considered it necessary to enquire all the Revered Priests of God to accept a traditional title then, I believe my people will follow me with one voice and mind to consider you for an outstanding title "Mmiri Na-Ezoro Oha I of Igbo Land". We cannot forget in our daily prayer to pray for all the families in the human services.

Dear Father, we lack words to thank you, the memory lane of your Good work is ever young. Even with silver and Gold we cannot thank you enough. We also owe a very big thanks to the director of Samuel Omogo Foundation.

As this borehole is being commissioned this day, the 29th of January, 2021, we dedicate it to God Almighty, we promise to take good care and maintenance of the borehole, we promise to accommodate every needy freely, as we freely received. As you go back from this occasion, may the good Lord guide and protect you, may you continue to be blessed, to your generation in Jesus name – Amen.
